II. Operation of menu functions:

AX505 Duo IS ANDROID DUAL SIM SMART PHONE

In the standby mode, select **Menu** and the desired menu and submenu. Select **End** or **Back** to exit the current level of menu. Press the end key to return to the standby mode directly.

Dialer

- Tap the dialer icon on the homescreen
- Enter the phone number
- Press call key,to dial the number
- Press the end key to end the call

Function Menu Instruction

1. Browser

Select the browser icon to enter the Google Interface and you can search for websites

2. Calculator

The handset is provided with a calculator with basic functions. You can carry out the operation for plus, minus, multiply, and divide by pressing the screen. You can use some functions in the advanced panel.

Attention: the accuracy is limited and round-off error may occur.

3. Calendar

Enter the calendar menu and there shall appear a calendar on the screen with the current date market out by background frame with a special color. Press the touch screen to browse date and the calendar information on the screen shall be correspondingly updated.

4. Camera

Under viewing condition, press the bottom icons to do the following operations. Press the middle icon to capture a picture or film a video, press the fourth icon to switch between camera mode and video mode. The fifth icon shows the currently captured picture or video.

5. Clock

New Alarm

Enter the clock menu and press alarm icon to add a new alarm. Scroll the scrollbar to set alarm time. Press alarm of list to edit the activation, Time, Repeat, Ringtone, Vibrate and Label, choose "done" to finish the setting. If you need to reset the settings, choose "Revert". If you want to delete the alarm, choose "Delete".

6. Downloads

You can check the downloaded or being-downloaded contents

7. Email

First you need to set the Email account.

Step 1: enter email address and password.

Step 2: select account type, choose OK to connect.

8. File Manager

You can manage file , including Download, Music, and Received File. Press menu key to create a new folder or select folders to copy, move and delete.

9. FM Radio

Attention: this handset doesn't have a built-in antenna. If you want to listen to the radio, please insert the headphone first. Pressing the side key can adjust the volume.

Storage

Include the SD card storage, available storage, insert SD card (If a SD card has add been inserted, then this option will become "Unmount SD card "), format SD card and all available storage in the internal storage space. Device can support SD card Upto 32GB.

Battery

The lithium ion battery attached to the Mobile phone is usable once it is unpacked. Initially battery is not fully charged. Battery will reach its best performance condition after three repetitions of charging & discharging. Battery power level indication:

- · Your Mobile phone can display charging level of the battery.
- Under normal condition, you can see available energy of the battery from the power level icon in top right corner of the display screen.

Note: Performance of the battery is subject to various factors, including your wireless network configuration, signal strength, and temperature when the Mobile Phone is used, selected and used functions and settings, and Accessories of your Phone, voice, data and other application program modes. III. Quick Start Guide:

- Turning the Mobile Phone on and off
 - To turn on the Phone

Press and hold the power key until the LCD screen turns on. Wait until the home screen appears, the tablet is ready for use.

To turn off the Phone

Press and hold the power key until the device options menu appears. Touch power off on the screen, confirmation message will appear.

Unlocking

When the screen turns off you will have to unlock the screen when you turn it back on. To unlock the screen, touch and hold lock icon and slide towards unlock icon.

When the Phone is on, you can turn off the screen to conserve battery power. Simply press the power key once to turn the screen off. Press the power key again to turn on the screen.

Connecting to a Computer

Connect to a computer to transfer files

- 1. Connect your Mobile Phone to the computer with the included USB cable
- a. Plug the small end of the cable into the USB 2.0 Hi-speed connector of the tablet
- b . Plug the large end of the cable into an available USB $2.0\,\mathrm{Hi}\text{-speed}$ port on the computer.
- When your Phone is connected, a USB icon will appear in the Notification window. Touch Notification window to expand.
- 3. Mount the storage drive

Touch USB connected to mount the Phones built-in storage, then touch Turn on USB storage when prompted to confirm. When mounted, you can copy files to/from your computer to it.

Your Phone will be recognized by the computer as Removable Storage drive. Drag and drop files between your Phone and the computer. To learn more about copying files, please refer to the documentation included with your computer or operating system.

IV. Troubleshooting:

Sr .No.	Failure	Solution
1	The Phone fails to power on	Check that the battery is charged; Check that the battery is installed correctly.
2	Insert SIM card error	1.Check whether the SIM card is dirty, if card is dirty, clean it; 2. Reinstall the SIM card; 3.If the SIM card is damaged replace the SIM card.
3	Low network	Check the signal strength indicator on the screen. 4 bars indicate strong signal and 2 bars or less indicate poor signal.
4	Call registration fails	1.You might have set the Hide Caller ID but the network operator does not support this service; 2.There may be strong signal interference; 3.You might have activated the Call Barring function; 4.You might have activated Line 2 but the network operator may not support this service.
5	Battery fails to charge	The battery may have excessively discharged To charge the battery it is necessary to connect it to a charger for certain period of time; The battery may have been deteriorated.
6	Can not connect to the network	1.Check whether signal is too weak or wireless interference exists around; 2.Check whether the SIM card is installed correctly, poor connection exists or the SIM card is damaged. If the SIM card is damaged please contact the network operator.
7	Photos shoot are too dark	The brightness is set too low; The ambient light is too dark.
8	Photos shot are too blurred	The object shot is moving; Your hand shakes when shutter is pressed.
9	Photos shot are distorted	The object shot is too close to the lens.
10	Cannot access the service menu	The SIM card may not support the service.

V. Specific Absorption Rate:

Mobile device is a radio transmitter and receiver. It is designed to not exceed the limits for exposure to radio waves

Recommended by various governments. In India, these guidelines were developed by the Government of India,

Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communications and IT and include safety margins design to assure the

Protection of all persons, regardless of age and health, and to account for any variations in measurements.

The guidelines use a unit of measurement known as the Specific Absorption Rate (SAR). SAR level for mobile handsets

Shall be limited to 1.6 Watt/kg, averaged over a 6 minutes period and taken over a volume containing a mass of 1 gram of Human issue.

Highest SAR Value for MAXX AX505 Duo as below-

For GSM 900MHz - When tested on Body - 0.283 Watt/Kg (1g) When tested on Head - 0.093 Watt/Kg (1g)

For GSM 1800MHz – When tested on Body – 0.775 Watt/Kg (1g) When tested on Head – 0.762 Watt/Kg (1g)

As SAR is measured utilizing the mobile device's highest transmitting power, the actual SAR of this mobile device while

Operating is typically below that indicated above. This is due to automatic changes to the power level of the mobile device

SAR levels of various mobile devices and at various positions, they meet the governmental requirements for safe exposure.
