


# Introduction

### Insert the SIM Card

1. Power off the mobile phone and remove the battery cover and battery.

2. Insert the SIM card correctly in the card slot(s) 1 or 2.




3. Insert the battery and battery cover of the mobile phone.

### Insert the Memory Card

1. Power off the mobile phone and remove the batter cover and battery.

- 2. Insert the Micro SD card into the slot.
- 3. Insert the battery and the battery cover of the mobile phone.



### Charging the Battery


Charge your battery by plugging the charger to the USB port of the phone.

Note: Please use only BLU authorized products



1. Press power button to enter Sleep Mode

2. Press power button to bring phone out of Sleep Mode. Drag the lock icon **UP** to unlock the phone.



### Home Screen

The home screen displays application icons, widgets, shortcuts, and other features.

### Notification Bar

At the top of the screen, the notification bar displays the time, status, and notifications. If there is a new message or missed call you may drag the bar down to open notification panel and click on any notifications pending.

### Application Menu

Click the application menu icon at the bottom of the screen to viewall installed applications.

### Adding Widgets and icons

Enter the application menu and long press an application icon until the screen appears. Then, select which screen where the icon will be placed, and release finger.

### Editing Widgets and Icons

Long press and hold the widget or icon that will be moved. Once the phone vibrates, drag the widget or icon to a new location on the screen.

Long press and hold the widget or icon that will be deleted. Once the phone vibrates, drag the widget or icon to the top of the screen so it may be removed.



The application menu displays icons for all of the applications on your phone. From the Home screen, click the application menu icon to enter.



Slide the menu left or right to display more icons


Press and hold the Home key to open the recent applications menu.



To make a call, click the dial key on the home screen to open the call interface. You may place a call the following ways:

Click the number keys to enter a telephone number and press the dial key to place a phone call.

Call a telephone number or contact from the call log.



# Call Log

Every telephone number called and received will be saved in the phone's call log. All numbers in the call log can be dialed directly by clicking the phone icon on the right side of the screen. When the number appears on the list, click it to view details.

You may also long press a number in the call log to edit, delete, save number and do other operations.




## Contacts

Click the add contact icon to add a new contact to either the phone or the SIM card.

# Messaging


You may use this function to exchange text messages and multimedia messages with yourfamily and friends. The messages to and from the same contact or phone number will be saved into a single conversation so you may see the entire message history conveniently.

1. Click contact icon to enter recipient

(You may enter contacts from the address book or enter a new number)

### Menu Functions

### Backward

After browsing through multiple pages, this option will return the user to the previous page.

### Forward

After browsing through multiple pages, this option will move to a

web page after the current page.

### Windows

You may view all windows open.

### Bookmarks

- Click the "Bookmarks" option to make the current URL as a saved bookmark.
- Click the bookmark under the bookmarks list, will open the URL.

### More

- Add bookmarks: Save the current URL as bookmark.
- Find on page: Search current page.
- Select text: Click and drag to select a piece of text.
- Page info: Display page address and other information of the current browsing.
- Share page: Select the Bluetooth or SMS to share the current page.
- History: Show your browsing history and view the most visited pages.
- Setting: Contains a variety of browser settings.


### Search Music

To turn off the Party Shuffle, press Menu and press the Party Shuffle option.




# Google Play
