## 2.1 INSTALLING CARDS &BATTERY

Please switch off your device before inserting or removing the battery/SIM card or memory card.

#### **Installing SIM Card and Battery**

Your device is provided with two SIM slots for two different SIM cards. In order to install battery and SIM card in the device, please follow the steps mentioned below:

- Remove the back cover of the device.
- Hold the device with front facing downwards; pull battery cover.
- Insert the SIM cards in the device.
- Attach the battery.
- Push the battery cover until it clicks into place.

### **Installing Memory Card**

Your device supports T-Flash card, which is a multimedia memory card used to multiply the memory of the device. The T-flash card is small and should be pulled out and installed carefully and prudently in order to avoid any kind of damage.
